How to Set Up Panopto for Recording

- 1. Grab your phone or tablet (iOS or Android)
- 2. Download the Panopto mobile app
- 3. On your laptop or desktop, login to panopto.humber.ca
- 4. Provision your course in Blackboard

Recording, Uploading and Embedding

Recording Tips

- Find a reasonably quiet space
- Speak slowly (this is helpful for captioning later, too)
- Avoid being backlit (eg. don't stand with your back to a window)

Upload Your Video through the Panopto app

1. Open the Panopto app and log in

- 2. Select "Record and Upload"
- 3. Choose the course folder that you created earlier

Embedding Your Video into Blackboard

- 1. Go back to your Blackboard course site
- 2. Go to the Getting Started menu
- 3. Select "Panopto Video Embed"
- 4. Select your video from the list

How to Caption Your Video

- 1. Log on to panopto.humber.ca, and find your video
- 2. Click "Edit"
- 3. Select "Captions" on the top
- 4. Select "Import Automatic Captions"
- 5. Edit the captions
