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## Introduction

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### How I Use My iPad

- A “Virtual Whiteboard” for my Keynote presentations (using GoodNotes)
- Capturing student assessments with the camera
- Playing musical examples

### My Wireless Setup

- iPad → Apple TV → HDMI → TV
- iPad → Apple TV → Podium → Projector

### My Wired Setup

iPad → USB-C Cable → Podium → Projector

### My Audio-Only Setup

iPad → USB-C to headphone adapter → Stereo Cable → Sound Board
