Time / rhythm

- Placement of the notes within the beat
- Articulation
- Phrasing (use of space, repetition, rhythmic variation, development)
- Style

Note choices

- Shape and contour of melody
- Connection to harmony (roots, guide tones, chord tones, extensions)
- Phrases based on patterns
- Tension and resolution

Communication

Interaction with rhythm section or other band members (creating a dialogue)
